## NOTICE TO ALL HAWTHORNE RESIDENTS!

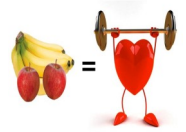
The Hawthorne Neighborhood Council will consider a proposed modification to the Hawthorne NRP Phase II plan as follows.

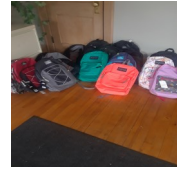
